#### Takeaways

- As of 2018 the region's population **increased by 1.9%** since 2013, growing by 1,184. Population is expected to **increase by 1.7%** between 2018 and 2023, adding 1,048.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 5.0% in LC Valley from 28,734 to 30,176. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 3.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 58.7% to 62.9% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.2% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.4% below the national average), and **9.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).






#### Job Trends








Millennials









#### **Top Growing Industries**






#### **Top Industry GRP**






#### **Top Growing Occupations**




#### **Top Occupation Earnings**


